ORDINANCE NO. 2018-07**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING
CHAPTER II ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION" CREATING A NEW SUBSECTION
2-23.4 ENTITLED "TAX COLLECTOR FEES" OF THE REVISED GENERAL
ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF SPRING LAKE HEIGHTS**

Chapter II of the General Ordinances of the Borough of Spring Lake Heights is hereby amended or supplemented as follows (new text is double underlined, text to be deleted is ~~struck through~~ and notations to the reader and changes in subparagraph designations either with or without changes to content are italicized):

SECTION 1:

2-23.4 Tax Collector

- a. Any party entitled to redeem a tax certificate shall be provided such calculation at no cost provided such no more than 2 requests have been made in the calendar year. All calculations thereafter shall require a fee of \$50.00.
- b. The Tax Collector shall charge any party seeking a redemption amount in order to file a foreclosure, the sum of \$50.00 for such calculation.
- c. All requests for calculations by the Tax Collector referenced herein shall be in writing and contain sufficient information to properly identify the property and party in the Tax Collector's sole discretion

SECTION 2: REPEALER All Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to such inconsistency.

SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance is adjudged to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to

section paragraph, subdivision, clause, or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law.
