

BOROUGH OF SPRING LAKE HEIGHTS

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING SECTION 7-12, ENTITLED "HANDICAPPED PARKING" OF CHAPTER VII (TRAFFIC) OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF SPRING LAKE HEIGHTS, NEW JERSEY

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Spring Lake Heights, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 7-12 entitled "Handicapped Parking" of Chapter VII (Traffic) of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Spring Lake Heights, New Jersey is hereby amended and supplemented together with "Schedule XVIII. PARKING AREA FOR HANDICAPPED PERSONS" in the following respects (additions are indicated by double underline; deletions are shown by ~~strikeout~~):

7-12 HANDICAPPED PARKING.

No person shall park ~~in the area situated on the premises~~ at the locations described in Schedule XVIII attached to and made a part of this chapter, unless they have been issued special vehicle identification cards by the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission, when using a motor vehicle for which a special vehicle identification card has been issued by the Commission.

SCHEDULE XVIII. PARKING AREA FOR HANDICAPPED PERSONS

In accordance with section 7-12, the parking area herein designated and established for handicapped persons only is for the use of persons who have been issued special vehicle identification cards by the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission, when using a motor vehicle on which is displayed a certificate for which a special vehicle identification card has been issued by such Commission. No other person shall park a vehicle or any part thereof within the bounds of such area.

SECTION 2. The provisions of this ordinance shall be severable. If any section or provision shall be held invalid by any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.


