ORDINANCE NO. 2016-02

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 9-2.1 ENTITLED “FEES” OF
CHAPTER IX (RECREATIONAL FACILITIES) OF THE REVISED
GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF SPRING LAKE
HEIGHTS, NEW JERSEY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Spring Lake Heights, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 9-2.1 entitled “Fees” of Chapter IX (Recreational Facilities) of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Spring Lake Heights, New Jersey is hereby amended to read as follows:

9-2.1 Fees. Fees for Spring Lake Heights Recreation programs, activities and services shall be established by resolution adopted by the Borough Council in accordance with the following maximum fees:

A. Program Fees - Resident:

Youth Summer Camp (multi-week program)	\$125.00
Youth Summer Camp (single week program)	\$50.00
Youth Summer Camp (single day program)	\$15.00
Youth Sports Leagues (per season).....	\$65.00
Adult Sports Leagues (per season)	\$75.00
Sports Clinics	\$50.00
Bus Trips (in addition to the event ticket cost).....	\$50.00
Other Activities	\$100.00

B. Program Fees - Non-Resident. Fees for non-resident participation in Recreation programs shall not exceed an additional fifty percent (50%) of the fee established for residents in paragraph A.

C. Recreation Program Vendor. Instructors providing recreation, health and fitness programs on a contractor-vendor basis shall pay a prorated monthly fee of not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) for three (3) sessions weekly. The fee charged participants for such program shall not exceed five dollars (\$5.00) per session.

D. Service Fees:

Late Registration.....	\$15.00
Returned payment	\$20.00

SECTION 2. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable. If any section or provision shall be held invalid by any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication in accordance with the law.
