**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SPRING LAKE HEIGHTS –
AMENDING CHAPTER IX RECREATIONAL FACILITIES , SECTION 9-1.2
PARKS AND COMMUNITY CENTER OF THE REVISED GENERAL
ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF SPRING LAKE HEIGHTS**

SECTION 1. Chapter 9 entitled “Recreation Facilities” of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Spring Lake Heights is hereby supplemented with the following revision:


9-1.2 Closing Times; Community Center Fee.

- a. The Community Center will be closed to all persons from 11:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. All parks will be closed from 9:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. except for those activities which are Borough sanctioned. (Ord. #17-1973; New)
- b. A deposit of ~~\$250.00~~ \$200.00 for residents and \$300.00 for non-residents is required to reserve the facility and is held against any violations of the Rules and Regulations and Fire Code Regulations and/or damages to the facility. Upon a favorable inspection after the rental, this fee will be returned.
- c. The fee for the Community Center shall be two hundred (\$200.00) for residents of Spring Lake Heights and three hundred (\$300.00) for non- residents plus proof of insurance with a minimum liability coverage in the amount of \$300,000.00 per occurrence. (Ord. No. 27-2010)

SECTION 2 The provisions of this ordinance shall be severable. If any section or provision shall be held invalid by any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3 All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.


SECTION 4 This ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication in accordance with the law.
