

**BOROUGH OF SPRING LAKE HEIGHTS
ORDINANCE NO. 2018-08**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING
CHAPTER IX ENTITLED "RECREATIONAL FACILITIES" OF THE REVISED
GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF SPRING LAKE HEIGHTS**

Chapter IX of the General Ordinances of the Borough of Spring Lake Heights is hereby amended or supplemented as follows (new text is double underlined, text to be deleted is ~~struck through~~ and notations to the reader and changes in subparagraph designations either with or without changes to content are italicized):

SECTION 1:

9-1 PARKS AND COMMUNITY CENTER.

9-1.2 Closing Times; Community Center Fee.

- a. The Community Center will be closed to all persons from 11:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. All parks will be closed from 9:00 p.m. to 8:00 am. except for those activities which are Borough sanctioned.
- b. A deposit of ~~two hundred fifty (\$250.00) dollars~~ \$200.00 for residents and \$300.00 for non-residents is required to reserve the facility and is held against any violations of the rules and regulations and Fire Code regulations and/or damages to the facility. Upon a favorable inspection after the rental, this fee will be returned.
- c. The fee for the Community Center shall be two hundred (\$200.00) dollars for residents of Spring Lake Heights and three hundred (\$300.00) dollars for nonresidents plus proof of insurance with a minimum liability coverage in the amount of three hundred thousand (\$300,000.00) dollars per occurrence.

9-2 RECREATION PROGRAMS; FEES.

9-2.1 Fees.

Fees for Spring Lake Heights Recreation programs, activities and services shall be established by resolution adopted by the Borough Council. ~~in accordance with the following maximum fees:~~

~~a. Program Fees—Resident:~~

Youth Summer Camp (multi-week program) ..	\$125.00
Youth Summer Camp (single week program) ...	\$50.00
Youth Summer Camp (single day program)	\$15.00
Youth Sports Leagues (per season).....	\$65.00
Adult Sports Leagues (per season)	\$75.00
Sports Clinics	\$50.00
Bus Trips (in addition to the event ticket cost)...	\$50.00
Other Activities	\$100.00

- ~~b. Program Fees – Nonresident. Fees for nonresident participation in Recreation programs shall not exceed an additional fifty percent (50%) of the fee established for residents in paragraph A.~~
- ~~c. Recreation Program Vendor. Instructors providing recreation, health and fitness programs on a contractor-vendor basis shall pay a prorated monthly fee of not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) for three (3) sessions weekly. The fee charged participants for such program shall not exceed five dollars (\$5.00) per session.~~



SECTION 2: REPEALER All Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to such inconsistency.


