5. DISCUSSION ITEMS:

- Health Fair –
 - Meridian will be contacting the Borough office to pick a date that is

available for both the Borough and Meridian Health. Chairperson Giles mentioned that he did attend the Fair, and he did like it. He had some screenings done and thought it was an event that is nice for the Borough. He also mentioned the Wall Touch a Truck Day, and that children really do love that. Also, the Fire Prevention aspect of it, and, that if we could have something similar, that that would be a way of bringing in more of the community. The Borough is going to attempt an early fall date, before sports activities begin for children, and before a portion of our population goes away for the colder months.

- Chairperson Giles brought up the subject of Narcan. He mentioned that there is an overdose epidemic going on, and noted his observation of “soccer moms” who now look for prescription pills; that it is actually not uncommon. It was also brought up that pills intended for grandparents for example, and others are taken by family members for whom the prescription is not written. It was asked whether Spring Lake Heights has Narcan available; the answer was not known.
- Chairperson Giles brought up the membership to the NJLBOH. The membership for the Board is \$95. He also mentioned that he was able to access the Association website and mentioned that there are some very beneficial online education opportunities. He recommends that the members of the Board check it out.
- Mike Kowal was asked about Sea Breeze Deli. He mentioned that he spoke to John the owner about food handling concerns.
- Mike Kowal also mentioned that immunization audits were done in February. Hill n Dale had 2 or 3 children without their full vaccinations. Since they are a small school, that makes their percentages appear higher.
- Chair Giles asked Mike if pool inspections had begun; Mike replied they would be starting shortly, but that some pools in the Borough do not open until later.
- Chair Giles confirmed that the rabies clinic is set for November 1, 2014 in Spring Lake Heights.
- Chair Giles brought up that the Commission had a proclamation regarding National Public Health Week April 7 to 13; that possibly the Borough could recognize the week, but next year maybe the Governing Body can be a part of the proclamation.
- Chairperson Giles inquired if there was any further discussion or anything to discuss. There was not.


